What is Launchpad?

- Software development portal like Sourceforge, GNU Savannah, Assembla
- Free Software. Released under Affero General Public License
- Features like Bug tracking, Code hosting, Translations, Blueprints, Answers, Packaging etc
- Written using Zope Framework

Components of Launchpad

- Bazaar – Code Hosting
- Malone – Bug Tracker
- Rosetta – Translations
- Blueprints – Collaborative design
- Answers – Knowledge Base
- Registry – People, projects, teams information
- Soyuz – Packaging

Important Projects using Launchpad

- Inkscape
- Mailman
- MySQL
- Drizzle

Launchpadlib Installation

- On Debian/Ubuntu

```
sudo apt-get install python-launchpadlib
```

- Using easy_install

```
sudo easy_install launchpadlib
```

Launchpad API

- RESTful web service
- launchpadlib client library
- Uses OAuth for authentication
- Provides proper API for various accessing various components

Login / Signing Requests

- Anonymous access
- Authenticated Access

Anonymous Access

```
> from launchpadlib.launchpad import Launchpad  
> cache_dir = '/home/manish/.launchpad/testing'  
> lp = Launchpad.login_anonymously('testing',  
'production', cache_dir)
```

First parameter is client name, second is installation type and third is the cache dir where it caches all fetched data

- HTTPError (401 Unauthorized) is raised when the user tries to change any value
- HTTPError (401 Unauthorized) is raised when the user tries to check his/her user profile

Authenticated Access

- `from launchpadlib.launchpad import Launchpad`
- `cache_dir = /home/manish/.launchpad/testing`
- `lp = Launchpad.login_with('testing', 'production', cache_dir)`

You can change the data if you authenticate with Launchpad

Fetching Data

- unaward = lp.bugs[632276]
- unaward.title
 - u'Wrap UnAwardTrophy'
- unaward.owner.display_name
 - u'Manish Sinha'
- unaward.id
 - 632276

Editing Data

```
> unaward = lp.bugs[632276]
> unaward.unsubscribe()
> x=unaward.subscribe(lp.me)
> x

Launchpad top-level Objects

- Collection like bugs, people, projects etc
- Entries like bug, branch, project, project_group, language etc
- Complete API at
